Wood surrounds for steel windows and doors

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Foreword

This British Standard has been prepared under the direction of the Timber Standards Committee and is a revision of the 1963 imperial edition which is now withdrawn.

Sizes are given in metric values in terms of SI units. For further information on SI units reference should be made to BS 3763 and PD 5686.

This revision specifies surrounds for use with metal windows complying with BS 990 : Part 2.

Previous editions of this standard specified the overall sizes of surrounds by reference to the actual heights and widths of the windows and doors they would contain; in this

edition co-ordinating heights and widths are determined by reference to the co-ordinating sizes of the windows and doors contained in BS 990 : Part 2.

Timber section sizes are specified which are economical for all sizes of window; alternative section sizes are given to enable external, dimensionally co-ordinated sizes to be maintained if desired.

Account has been taken of the principles of dimensional co-ordination as laid down in BS 4011, BS 4330 and PD 6444 : Part 1.
