National foreword

This Part of BS 3762 has been prepared under the direction of the Chemicals Standards Committee. It is identical with ISO 607:1980 “*Surface active agents and detergents — Methods of sample division*”, published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

This Part supersedes part 1 of BS 3762:1964 (which effected division of solid samples using either a radial sampling tool or a multiple slot divider) by methods using a conical or a rotary sample divider and gives, additionally, methods for the division of samples in paste or in liquid form.

Terminology and conventions. The text of the International Standard has been approved as suitable for publication as a British Standard without deviation. Some terminology and certain conventions are not identical with those used in British Standards; attention is drawn especially to the following. Wherever the words “International Standard” appear, referring to this standard, they should be read as “Part of this British Standard”.

Cross-reference. The Technical Committee has reviewed the provisions of ISO 6206, to which reference is made in clause 3, and has decided that they are suitable for use in conjunction with this standard.

A related British Standard to ISO 6206 is BS 5309 “*Methods for sampling chemical products*”, Part 1 “*Introduction and general principles*”.

A British Standard does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract. Users of British Standards are responsible for their correct application.

Compliance with a British Standard does not of itself confer immunity from legal obligations.
