Foreword

This British Standard has been prepared under the direction of the Iron and Steel Standards Policy Committee and is a revision of BS 4087 : 1966 which is withdrawn.

This standard specifies the properties of wire which has been copper-covered by the electrolytic deposition process. Copper-covered steel wire manufactured by a different process may be supplied provided that all the requirements of this standard are met.

In this revision all references to Imperial units have been deleted, small changes to phosphorous and sulphur limits are incorporated and reference to the rate of twisting in the torsion tests has been deleted.

Compliance with a British Standard does not of itself confer immunity from legal obligations.
