Foreword

This revision of BS 5599 was prepared under the direction of the Surface Treatments and Coatings Standards Policy Committee. It specifies requirements for hard anodic oxidation coatings on aluminium and its alloys for engineering purposes. It supersedes BS 5599:1978, which is withdrawn.

This revision of BS 5599 differs from the previous edition in that it includes information to be supplied by the purchaser, on the selection of aluminium or aluminium alloy, on thickness of anodic oxidation coating, on special characteristics required and on process qualification and approval.

This revision also includes informative annexes on sampling procedures, packaging and delivery of anodized articles and on some processes used with hard anodic oxidation coatings.

A British Standard does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract. Users of British Standards are responsible for their correct application.
