National foreword

This British Standard, which was prepared under the direction of the Power Electrical Engineering Standards Committee, is a multi-Part standard. Part 1, which specifies general requirements, implements Harmonization Document No. 394-1 of the European Committee for Electrotechnical Standardization (CENELEC). It is identical with IEC Publication 614-1 : 1978 'Specification for conduits for electrical installations Part 1 : General requirements', published by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC).

Particular requirements for specific types of conduit will be covered by different Sections of Part 2.

Terminology and conventions. The text of the international standard has been approved as suitable for publication as a British Standard without deviation. Some terminology and certain conventions are not identical with those used in British Standards; attention is especially drawn to the following.

In the figures, the comma has been used as a decimal marker. In British Standards it is current practice to use a full point on the baseline as the decimal marker.

Where page numbers are quoted in the text, they refer to IEC page numbers.
