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National foreword

This Part of BS 6413 has been prepared under the direction of the Petroleum Standards Committee in order to provide a classification scheme for lubricants, industrial oils and related products. It is identical with ISO 6743/8-1987 'Lubricants, industrial oils and related products (class L) — Classification — Part 8: Family R (Temporary protection against corrosion)', published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO). ISO 6743/8 was prepared as a result of discussion in Subcommittee 4, Classifications and specifications, of Technical Committee 28, Petroleum products and lubricants, in which the UK participated.

A general classification of petroleum products prepared in ISO/TC 28 has allocated class L to lubricants. BS 6413 : Part 0 details the subdivision of class L into families of products, to each of which a code letter is allocated. This Part provides a detailed classification within family R of class L. Further Parts of the international standard will provide a detailed classification within other families of class L and will be published as further Parts of BS 6413.

Terminology and conventions. The text of the international standard has been approved as suitable for publication as a British Standard without deviation. Some terminology and certain conventions are not identical with those used in British Standards; attention is drawn especially to the following.

Wherever the words 'part of ISO 6743' appear, referring to this standard, they should be read as 'Part of BS 6413'.
