National foreword

This revision of Section 2.2 of BS 684, which has been prepared under the direction of the Food and Agriculture Standards Committee, supersedes BS 684-2.2:1976, which is withdrawn. It differs from BS 684-2.2:1976 in that the temperature of ignition is 550 °C to 600 °C and not 600 °C, the crucible may be of platinum (as well as silica) but not porcelain and a procedure for acid oils is included.

This Section is identical with ISO 6884:1985 “*Animal and vegetable fats and oils — Determination of ash*” published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) and in the preparation of which the UK played a full part.

Terminology and conventions. The text of the International Standard has been approved as suitable for publication as a British Standard without deviation. Some terminology and certain conventions are not identical with those used in British Standards; attention is drawn especially to the following.

The comma has been used as a decimal marker. In British Standards it is current practice to use a full point on the baseline as the decimal marker. In British Standards it is current practice to use the symbol “mL” for millilitre rather than “ml”.

Wherever the words “International Standard” appear, referring to this standard, they should be read as “British Standard”.
