This British Standard reproduces verbatim ISO 3911:1998 and implements it as the UK national standard. In addition to implementation of the ISO publication this British Standard also contains a national annex giving guidance for lateral and radial run-out values in relation to the construction and workmanship of wheels and rims for pneumatic tyres. It supersedes BS AU 50-2.0a:1979 which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee AUE/4, Tyres and wheels for motor vehicles, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
