This British Standard was published by BSI. It is the UK implementation of EN 1015-11:1999, incorporating amendment A1:2006. It is included in a package of standards relating to ties, tension straps, hangers, brackets, bed joint reinforcement, masonry mortar and rendering and plastering mortar which supersedes the following British Standards which are withdrawn:

BS 4551-1:1998, *Methods of testing mortars, screeds and plasters — Part 1: Physical testing*;

BS 4721:1981, *Specification for ready-mixed building mortars*;

BS 5838-2:1980, *Specification for dry packaged cementitious mixes — Part 2: Prepacked mortar mixes*.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags **A1** **A1**. Tags indicating changes to CEN text carry the number of the CEN amendment. For example, text altered by CEN amendment A1 is indicated by **A1** **A1**.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee B/519, Masonry and associated testing, to Subcommittee B/519/2, Mortar.
