This British Standard is the English language version of EN 10258 : 1996. It supersedes the requirements for dimensions and shape of cold-rolled narrow strip and cut lengths in BS 1449 : Part 2 : 1983 and in BS 1501 : Part 3 : 1990. Both of these British Standards have been amended.
