National foreword

This British Standard is the official English language version of EN 12122:2005. It supersedes BS EN 12122:1999 which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee CII/59, Chemicals for drinking water treatment, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.

The United Kingdom, as a member of CEN, is obliged to publish EN 12122 as a British Standard. However, attention is drawn to the fact that the United Kingdom voted against the approval of EN 12122. The main reason for this disapproval was that no information was provided on the preparation of the test solution or the calculation of the result for the determination of iron, in order to apply the method referred to in **5.2.2.2** which is intended for the analysis of water.
