This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 12245:2022. It supersedes BS EN 12245:2009+A1:2011, which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee PVE/3/3, Transportable Gas Containers - Cylinder Design, Construction and Testing at the Time of Manufacture.

The UK committee notes that EN 12245:2022 has incorporated significant improvements over previous versions of this standard. However, the UK committee holds the view that the publication of this standard should have been delayed until advice with regards to burst pressure to test pressure ratios for different fibre materials, sought from ISO/TC 58 SC 3, was received and acted on.
