National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 12952-10:2002. Together with BS EN 12952-1:2001, BS EN 12952-2:2001, BS EN 12952-3:2001, BS EN 12952-5:2001, BS EN 12952-6:2002, BS EN 12952-7:2002 and BS EN 12952-11:2007, it supersedes BS 1113:1999 which remains current and obsolescent.

The obsolescent status means that the standard will no longer be updated. This status is given to BS 1113:1999 on the basis that there are numerous boilers throughout the world with long expectations of life that will require use of this standard for service and repair, enabling justification of continued service of the boilers.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee PVE/2, Water-tube and shell boilers.
