This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 13277-3:2013. It supersedes BS EN 13277-3:2000+A1:2007 which is withdrawn.

The UK committee voted against the approval of this standard. The reason for this is that the UK experts expressed the opinion that the descriptions of test equipment and test tolerances lacked necessary detail. This could result in larger correlation variance in the test between facilities.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee PH/3/11, Protective Equipment For Sports Players.
