This British Standard is the official English language version of EN 14035-2:2003, including Corrigendum January 2005. Together with BS EN 14035-1:2003, it supersedes BS 7114-1:1988 which has been declared obsolescent.

NOTE BS 7114-1:1998 has not been withdrawn immediately because it is cited in The Fireworks (Safety) Regulations 1997.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee CII/47, Fireworks, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
