National foreword

This British Standard is the official English language version of EN 14035-34:2003, including Corrigendum January 2005. It partially supersedes BS 7114-2:1988 and BS 7114-3:1988 which have been declared obsolescent.

NOTE BS 7114-2:1988 and BS 7114-3:1988 are cited in The Fireworks (Safety) Regulations 1997.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee CII/47, Fireworks, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.

A list of organizations represented on this committee can be obtained on request to its secretary.

Additional information

The United Kingdom, as a member of CEN, is obliged to publish EN 14035-34:2003 as a British Standard and to incorporate the corrigendum EN 14035-34/AC:2005. However, attention is drawn to the fact that the United Kingdom voted against the approval of the draft corrigendum.

The main reason for this disapproval is that BSI Committee CII/47 considers that Figure 3 in 8.6, as changed by the corrigendum, is still inaccurate because various elements of the figure are too small. The BSI Committee recommends that if a transparent template is used to check type sizes on labelling, the template should be accurately produced so that the height of each character and symbol on the template is within $^{+0.1}_0$ mm of the relevant minimum height specified in this standard.
