National foreword

This British Standard is the official English language version of EN 14126:2003, including Corrigendum September 2004.

The United Kingdom as a member of CEN, is obliged to publish EN 14126 as a British Standard. However, attention is drawn to the fact that during the development of this European Standard, the United Kingdom consistently voted against its approval as a European Standard.

The reason for this disapproval is that at the time of publication ISO 22610 and ISO 22611 have not reached final draft stage and the content may change before they do reach that stage. The UK cannot therefore guarantee that the final versions of these ISOs will convey the information originally intended by the authors of this standard.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee PH/3, Protective clothing to Subcommittee PH/3/3, Clothing for protection against chemicals which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
