National foreword

This British Standard is the official English language version of EN 15380-3:2006.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee RAE/1, Railway applications, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.

This standard has been produced from Part 4 of the DIN 25002 series of standards under the CEN fast-track procedure. The UK voted against the document in both associated ballots stating that the translation of the documents from German to prepare the English version has resulted in a lack of clarity as to the intent and meaning of some of the terminology used. There is a concern that some of the railway-related terminology used does not correspond to UK usage. Therefore, this standard should be applied with care and consideration in order to avoid misunderstanding.
