This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 1775:2007. It supersedes BS EN 1775:1998 which is withdrawn.

This standard describes the common principles and recognized practices concerning the design, construction, operation and maintenance necessary for the safety and integrity of gas supply systems, and takes the form of general requirements and recommendations. Further requirements for use within the UK can be found in BS 6891:2005, Installation of low pressure gas pipework of up to 35 mm (R1¼) in domestic premises (2nd family gas) — Specification and the Institution of Gas Engineers and Managers publication, IGE/UP/2, Gas installation pipework, boosters and compressors on industrial and commercial premises.
