This British Standard is the English language version of EN 50237:1997 published by the European Committee for Electrotechnical Standardization (CENELEC).

- In the title of Figure 7, "see **7.3.3**" has been changed to "see **7.3.5**";
- In the title of Figure 10, "see **7.3.5**" has been changed to "see **7.3.3**";
- In the title of Figure 12, "see **7.6.1**" has been changed to "see **7.5.3**";
- In the title of Figure 14, "see **7.6.2** and **8.6**" has been changed to "see **7.5.2** and **7.6.6**";
- In **E.4**, "must" has been changed to "shall".

These errors were also noted in the German version, DIN EN 50237, September 1998, but the French language publication NF EN 50237:1997 does not include these corrections.
