

Cable glands for electrical installations

This British Standard is the official English language version of EN 50262:1998, including amendments A1:2001 and A2:2004. It supersedes BS 6121-2:1989 and BS 6121-3:1990 which are withdrawn. Also, together with BS 6121-1:2005 it supersedes BS 6121-1:1989, which is withdrawn.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags **A1** **A1**. Tags indicating changes to CENELEC text carry the number of the CENELEC amendment. For example, text altered by CENELEC amendment A1 is indicated by **A1** **A1**.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee GEL/20, Electric cables, to Subcommittee GEL/20/11/1 (formerly GEL/20/8), Cable glands, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
