This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 55022:2010, incorporating corrigendum October 2011. It is derived from CISPR 22:2008. It supersedes BS EN 55022:2006+A2:2010 which is withdrawn.

This Standard is partially superseded by BS EN 50561-1:2013 to the effect that after 9 October 2016 it should no longer be used for the purposes of radio disturbance characteristics for in-home communication apparatus that use the low-voltage power installation as the transmission medium in the frequency range 1,606 5 MHz to 30 MHz.

The CENELEC common modifications have been implemented at the appropriate places in the text. The start and finish of each common modification is indicated in the text by **[C]** **[C]**.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by corrigendum is indicated in the text by tags. Text altered by CENELEC corrigendum October 2011 is indicated in the text by **[AC1]** **[AC1]**.
