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### National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 60335-2-69:2012. It is derived from IEC 60335-2-69:2012. It supersedes BS EN 60335-2-69:2009 which is withdrawn.

The CENELEC common modifications have been implemented at the appropriate places in the text. The start and finish of each common modification is indicated in the text by tags **Ⓒ** **Ⓓ**.

The UK national committee voted against the final draft of this standard as it sees no reason to prohibit the use of flow-through collector motors, as stated in Subclause CC.4.201. It is the opinion of the national committee that flow-through collector motors can be used in Cat 3 D (Zone 22) applications if they satisfy provisions given in IEC 61241 parts 0 and 1.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee CPL/61, Safety of household and similar electrical appliances, to Subcommittee CPL/61/10, Floor treatment machines (industrial).
