This British Standard is the English language version of EN 60352-1:1997. It is identical with IEC 60352-1:1997 including Corrigendum October 1998. It supersedes BS EN 60352-1:1997 (formerly BS 6516-1:1984) which will be withdrawn on 1998-07-01.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee EPL/48, Electromechanical components for electronic equipment, to Subcommittee EPL/48/2, Connectors for electronic equipment, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
