This British Standard was published by BSI. It is the UK implementation of EN 60601-2-13:2006, incorporating amendment A1:2007. It is identical with IEC 60601-2-13:2003, incorporating amendment 1:2006. Together with BS EN ISO 8835-4:2004, BS EN ISO 8835-5:2004 and when published BS EN ISO 8835-2 and BS EN ISO 8835-3 they will supersede BS EN 740:1999, which will be withdrawn on 1 May 2009.

The start and finish of text introduced or altered by amendment is indicated in the text by tags **A1** **A1**. Tags indicating changes to IEC text carry the number of the IEC amendment. For example, text altered by IEC amendment 1 is indicated by **A1** **A1**.
