This British Standard is the official English language version of EN 61241-14:2004. It is identical with IEC 61241-14:2004. It partially supersedes BS EN 50281-1-2:1999 which is being kept current until publication of BS EN 61241-17 and which will be withdrawn on 2007-09-01. It also partially supersedes BS 6467-1:1985 and BS 6467-2:1988 which are being kept current until publication of BS EN 61241-0, BS EN 61241-1 and BS EN 61241-17.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee GEL/31, Electrical apparatus for explosive atmospheres, to Subcommittee GEL/31/20, Electrical apparatus for use in the presence of combustible dusts, which has the responsibility to:

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- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
