Part 4: Particular requirements for assemblies for construction sites (ACS)

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National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 61439-4:2013. It is identical to IEC 61439-4:2012. It supersedes BS EN 60439-4:2004 which is withdrawn.

This British Standard applies to low-voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies. In addition to this standard, users could also consult British Standards BS 7375 and BS 7671 for details of UK national practice in the application and installation of this equipment. Further, the UK committee recommends that the assembly be marked to show whether overcurrent detection has, or has not, been supplied as part of the incomer arrangement.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee PEL/17, Switchgear, controlgear, and HV-LV co-ordination, to Subcommittee PEL/17/3, Low voltage switchgear and controlgear assemblies.
