This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN 806-5:2012. Together with BS EN 806-1:2000, BS EN 806-2:2005, BS EN 806-3:2006 and BS EN 806-4:2010, it supersedes BS 6700:2006+A1:2009, which will be withdrawn on 01 August 2012.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee B/504/2, Water Supply - Internal systems and components.

A list of organizations represented on this committee can be obtained on request to its secretary.

Users of this standard should note that there will be a short period of co-existence between BS 6700:2006+A1:2009 and the BS EN 806 series, to assist UK industry with the transition from BS 6700 to the BS EN 806 series of standards. In addition, BS 8558:2011 has been published to be read in conjunction with the BS EN 806 series.

BS 8558:2011, *Guide to the design, installation, testing and maintenance of services supplying water for domestic use within buildings and their curtilages – Complementary guidance to BS EN 806*, incorporates parts of BS 6700:2006+A1:2009, *Design, installation, testing and maintenance of services supplying water for domestic use within buildings and their curtilages – Specification*, as they are not detailed in the BS EN 806 series of standards.

This publication does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract. Users are responsible for its correct application.
