4National foreword

This British Standard is the official English language version of EN 846-11:2000, which is included in a package of new European Standards being prepared by CEN/TC 125 relating to ancillary components for masonry - lintels. Although the English language versions of these European Standards will be adopted as British Standards as they become available, the existing British Standards for lintels will be retained, but only until such time that the complete package of European Standards becomes available. Any residue(s) from British Standards affected by the package which need to be retained, will be drawn together to form a new BS. The original group of British Standards will then be withdrawn and this will be notified in *Update Standards*.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted by Technical Committee B/519, Masonry and associated tests, to Subcommittee B/519/3, Ancillary components, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
