Regarding the cleaning procedure given in Annex B, it should be noted that excessive heating may deform the seals and seating of cylinder valves and can lead to subsequent leakage or valve failure. It is therefore important that, during the drying stage of the cleaning procedure, the maximum temperature recommended by the manufacturer for the cylinder valves is not exceeded.
