National foreword

This British Standard is the UK implementation of EN ISO 11143:2008. It is identical to . It supersedes BS EN ISO 11143:2000 which is withdrawn.

In the United Kingdom, Statutory Instrument and Legislation control the installation of all water fittings, hereafter referred to as the Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999. Therefore, it is a legal requirement for all plumbing installations installed in England and Wales after 1 July 1999 to comply with the requirements of the Water Supply (Water Fittings) Regulations 1999. Similarly, all installations installed in Scotland after 4 April 2000 will need to comply with the Water Byelaws 2000, now the Scottish Water Byelaws 2004. Similar legislation covers Northern Ireland; particular attention should be given to Regulation/Byelaw 5.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee CH/106/4, Dental Instruments and Equipment.
