This British Standard is the official English language version of EN ISO 14644-4:2001. It is identical with ISO 14644-4:2001. It supersedes BS 5295-2:1989 which is withdrawn.

The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee LBI/30, Cleanroom technology, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.
