National foreword

This British Standard is the English language version of EN ISO 8442-2:1997. It is identical with ISO 8442-2:1997. It partially supersedes BS 5577:1984 which is to be amended to cover only table cutlery with non-metallic handles. The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee CW/17, Cutlery and table holloware, which has the responsibility to:

- aid enquirers to understand the text;
- present to the responsible international/European committee any enquiries on the interpretation, or proposals for change, and keep the UK interests informed;
- monitor related international and European developments and promulgate them in the UK.

A list of organizations represented on this committee can be obtained on request to its secretary.

The textual errors set out below were discovered when the English language version of EN ISO 8442-2 was adopted as the national standard. They have been reported to CEN in a proposal to amend the text of the European Standard.

- In 5.4 second paragraph delete “inclined” and replace with “included”
- In B.2.5 replace “200 mm to 250 mm” by “200 µm to 250 µm”
- In D.2 Note replace “Figure D.2” by “Figure D.1”
- In D.3.3 replace “Connect the test load” by “Connect the test load (30N ± 1N)”
- In Figure D.1 replace “(see table 2)” by “30N”
- In Figure D.2 replace “Figure D.2” by “Figure D.2”
