Aircraft lampholders

Foreword

This British Standard has been prepared at the request of the aircraft industry to state the requirements for bayonet lampholders suitable for use in aircraft lighting installations. The requirements for bi-pin fluorescent tube holders and for lampholders suitable for use at altitudes above 10 000 ft are under consideration.

Reference to the following British Standards is required:

BS 2G 100, *General requirements for electrical equipment and indicating instruments for aircraft.*

BS G 181, *Electric lamps for aircraft.*

BS 52, *Bayonet lamp-caps, lampholders and B.C. adaptors (lampholder-plugs) for voltages not exceeding 250 volts.*
