This British Standard is the UK implementation of IEC 60747-10:1991. It is identical to IEC 60747-10:1991.

BS QC 700000:1991/IEC 747-10:1991 (renumbered as BS IEC 60747-10:1991) and BS IEC 60748-11:2000 supersede BS 9450:1998, which has a status of obsolescence but remains available for use in connection with existing component approvals.

The Technical Committee has reviewed the provisions of IEC 27, IEC 50, IEC 410, IEC 747-11, QC 001002, and ISO 2859 to which reference is made in the text, and has decided that they are acceptable for use in conjunction with this standard. Related British Standards to IEC 50, IEC 410, QC 001002, and ISO 2859 are BS 6100-3.1, BS 6001-1, BS 9000-3, and BS 6001, respectively.

This publication does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract. Users of British Standards are responsible for its correct application.
