The UK participation in its preparation was entrusted to Technical Committee IST/12, Banking security and other financial services.

It is anticipated that all current and further messages developed according to the design rules and guidelines defined in this standard will, after a period of interoperability, be superseded by equivalent messages fulfilling the same business purpose developed according to the methodology defined in ISO 20022. Subject to the normal ISO procedures for periodic review, it is expected that ISO 15022 will eventually be withdrawn when it is no longer required by the industry it serves.
