Foreword

This British Standard has been prepared under the authority of the Shipbuilding and Marine Industry Standards Committee and is based upon a proposal by the Ship and Boat Builders' National Federation.

This standard has been prepared in order to meet a growing need for interchangeability of slides used in various track and slide fittings on board yachts. A wide adoption of these dimensions will also benefit both manufacturer and user in rationalizing a principal feature of design production.

Two basic forms of track section have been covered, namely a flattened "C" section for internal fitting and a stub "T" for external fitting. Two sizes are given for both sections in order to meet the great majority of present needs in yachting. A third large size has been added for the external fitting to meet a minor but significant need of the largest yachts.

A British Standard does not purport to include all the necessary provisions of a contract. Users of British Standards are responsible for their correct application.

Compliance with a British Standard does not of itself confer immunity from legal obligations.
