National foreword

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It is being issued in the Draft for Development series of publications and is of a provisional nature because it is considered that further experience is required in its application before it is converted into a British Standard. It should be applied on this provisional basis, so that information and experience of its practical application may be obtained.

Comments arising from the use of this Draft for Development are requested so that UK experience can be reported to the European organization responsible for its conversion into a European Standard. A review of this prestandard will be initiated 2 years after its publication so that a decision can be taken on its status at the end of its three year life. The commencement of the review period will be notified by an announcement in *Update Standards*.

According to the replies received by the end of the review period, the responsible BSI Committee will decide whether to support the conversion into a European Standard, to extend its life or to withdraw it. Comments should be sent in writing to the Secretary of BSI Technical Committee PAI/10, Paper towels and toilet paper, at 389 Chiswick High Road, London W4 4AL, giving the document reference and clause number and proposing, where possible, an appropriate revision of the text.
