Foreword

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards bodies (ISO member bodies). This second edition cancels and replaces the first edition (ISO 1718:1974), which has been technically revised (addition of sizes 7° × 25 and 12° × 25, amendments of lengths and deletion of tapered bits and thimbles).

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
