Foreword

ISO (the International Organization for Standardization) is a worldwide federation of national standards bodies (ISO member bodies). This second edition cancels and replaces the first edition (ISO 1929:1974), of which the table in subclause 4.2 (corresponding to table 2 in the present edition) has been technically revised.
