42 UP TO AND INCLUDING 100 mm THREAD DIAMETER

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BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 288/II-1969, *Slotted and castle nuts with metric thread – 42 up to and including 100 mm thread diameter*, was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 2, *Bolts, nuts and accessories*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Deutscher Normenausschuss (DNA). It is an addendum to ISO Recommendation R 288-1963, *Slotted and castle nuts with metric thread*, which covers thread diameters up to and including 39 mm.

Work on this question by the Technical Committee began in 1966 and led, in 1967, to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In September 1967, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 1277) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved, subject to a few modifications of an editorial nature, by the following Member Bodies :

The Draft ISO Recommendation was then submitted by correspondence to the ISO Council, which decided, in January 1969, to accept it as an ISO RECOMMENDATION.
