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BRIEF HISTORY

The ISO Recommendation R 774, *Taper keys with or without gib head and their corresponding keyways (Dimensions in millimetres)* was drawn up by Technical Committee ISO/TC 16, *Keys and keyways*, the Secretariat of which is held by the Institut Belge de Normalisation (IBN).

Work on this question by the Technical Committee led in 1965 to the adoption of a Draft ISO Recommendation.

In November 1966, this Draft ISO Recommendation (No. 1085) was circulated to all the ISO Member Bodies for enquiry. It was approved, subject to a few modifications of an editorial nature, by the following Member Bodies :

No Member Body opposed the approval of the Draft.

The Draft ISO Recommendation was then submitted by correspondence to the ISO Council, which decided, in January 1969, to accept it as an ISO RECOMMENDATION.
